



Dollar General Announces 19,000th Store Opening

JANUARY 28, 2023 (DOLLAR GENERAL)

Dollar General (NYSE: DG) commemorated the grand opening of its 19,000th store in Joplin, Missouri today with a community celebration and \$19,000 donation to a local elementary school. Customers also received complimentary DG gift cards, tote bags and product samples.

In keeping with Dollar General's mission of Serving Others, Dollar General donated \$19,000 and 100 new books to Royal Heights Elementary School in Joplin to support ongoing literacy and education programs.

The Company believes the addition of each new store provides positive economic benefits including additional access to affordable products for customers; the creation of new jobs and career development opportunities for employees; the generation of additional tax revenue; and the ability for local nonprofits, schools and libraries to apply for literacy and education grants through the Dollar General Literacy Foundation.

"Today marks an exciting milestone in Dollar General's history as we open our 19,000th store," said Jeff Owen, Dollar General's chief executive officer. "Since opening our first Missouri store in 1973, Dollar General has a longstanding history in the state and proudly employs more than 6,000 Missourians through our store, distribution center and DG Private Fleet. I would like to express my sincere gratitude to the entire Dollar General family whose dedication to our customers helped us to reach this milestone. We look forward to continuing to serve the Joplin community."

"Joplin schools have been intentionally working to **improve primarily literacy** in the Joplin community," said Breanna Faircloth, principal at Royal Heights Elementary. "We are extremely grateful for the Dollar General donation to further **enhance these efforts,** bringing us closer to achieving reading proficiency for all students."

Dollar General Plans to Open 1,050 Locations in 2023

Dollar General is continuing its rapid expansion into fiscal 2023 with plans for 1,050 new stores, following a successful Q3 2022 when sales rose 11.1% to \$9.5 billion.

The quarter, which ended Oct. 28, also saw a **6.8% increase** in same-store sales driven by **larger basket sizes** and a small increase in traffic.

Dollar General also is growing through the addition of three 1-million-squarefoot distribution centers in an approximately \$480 million combined investment announced in July. The facilities will support the DG Private Fleet and help the retailer achieve its goal of creating 10,000 net new jobs in 2022.

"We are thankful to our team for their continued dedication to serving others, particularly in a challenging economic and operating environment," said Jeff Owen, CEO of Dollar General in a statement. "We are pleased with our strong sales growth in the quarter, as well as a **modest increase** in customer traffic and continued share gains in both consumable and non-consumable product sales, all of which we believe are a testament to the **strength** of the value and convenience proposition we offer our customers."

The off-price retailer executed on **800 retail projects** in Q3 2022 and plans to execute on an additional **3,170** in the coming year. These efforts include 2,000 remodels, and 120 store relocations and up to **35 stores** in Mexico.

The company also expanded its interest in medtail with the appointment of four members to its healthcare advisory panel. The retailer is developing **investment strategies** in the health and wellness category but has yet to make an official move.











Native American tribes are making a big economic impact in Tulsa

Native American tribes in Oklahoma have poured more than \$15.6 billion into the state, while generating billions more from companies that support the tribes' business operations, according to the most recent Oklahoma Native Impact report (fiscal year 2019).

The report illustrates how Oklahoma's **38 federally** recognized tribes have made an unprecedented impact on the Sooner State's economy through a **diverse portfolio of businesses including** gaming and hospitality, manufacturing, real estate, retail and professional services, among others.

The Cherokee Nation is the largest tribe in the United States, with more than 450,000 citizens worldwide. The Cherokee Nation Business (CNB) is the holding company for the tribe's business enterprises, and with more than 11,000 employees is one of the largest employers in northeastern Oklahoma. The annual economic impact the tribe and its businesses have on the region is more than \$3 billion.

That impact comes from a **variety of businesses** under CNB. "Think about it in three big buckets," said Andy McMillan, CNB director of **economic development** and special projects. "There are companies within each of those, but the first would be that we do a lot of gaming and hospitality. So that encompasses casino gaming properties, hotels, some golf properties as well. For Tulsa and the Tulsa market, it's our Hard Rock Hotel and Casino on the east side of Tulsa. That's kind of a flagship property for us.

The second "bucket" is Cherokee Federal, which is a large federal contractor. "Lots of work with the United States Department of Defense [DOD]. Lots of work with other federal agencies where we provide program management, staffing, logistics management, all kinds of sort of contract support for things that the federal government wants to do and procure, both here in the United States, and some of the contract work that we support is overseas as well, on behalf of the federal government."



This \$2 Billion Theme Park Is Expected to Be the Disney World of Oklahoma — What We Know so Far

The \$2 billion theme park destination, American Heartland Theme Park and Resort, is proposed to be a 1,000-acre resort destination that is expected to attract around 5 million guests per year, the park said in a press release shared on Wednesday. The project's design team is made up of over 20 former Disney Parks builders and Walt Disney Imagineers.

American Heartland will be located outside Vinita on the historic Route 66 and will feature a large-scale RV park, world-class theme park, 300-room hotel, and modern indoor water park.

A new Americana-themed amusement park and resort complex — with amenities comparable to Disney World — is coming to Oklahoma.

The anchor of the proposed destination will be American Heartland Theme Park, which will feature an Americana-themed environment with a variety of entertaining rides, live shows, family attractions, waterways as well as **restaurant-quality food** and beverage offerings.

Thrilling rides and heartwarming shows" will be spread across six distinctly American themed lands: Great Plains, Bayou Bay, Big Timber Falls, Stony Point Harbor, Liberty Village and Electropolis.


At 125-acres, it will be comparable in size to Magic Kingdom Park at Walt Disney World.

Adjacent to the theme park will be the **320-acre** Three Ponies RV Park and Campground, anticipated to be the largest campground in the Central United States. The RV resort will feature **300 cabins**, 750 RV spaces, and on-site amenities.
