Automotive service is the largest part of Bridgestone Retail Operations, LLC's business, accounting for approximately fifty percent of sales with tire and financial services making up the rest.

Bridgestone Firestone North American Tire manufactures Bridgestone, Firestone, and Dayton truck tires along with tires for virtually every wheeled vehicle made. Harvey S. Firestone (1868-1938) founded The Firestone Tire & Rubber Company in Akron, Ohio, in August 1900, and started marketing solid rubber tires for carriage wheels. Firestone joined the retail store arena offering basic car service and tire sales in the mid1920s when the original Firestone Service Centers were opened. In the late 1970s the company, in an effort to re-focus its business solely on automotive service and tire sales, began to phase out the sale of all non-auto related merchandise. Shortly thereafter, in 1981, the Firestone Master Care Car Service concept was introduced and established as a premier brand of quality service being delivered to customers in a consistent and distinctive manner. Bridgestone Corporation, founded in 1931 in Kurume, Japan, purchased Firestone in 1988, transforming the company in to the world's largest manufacturer of tires and other rubber products. Bridgestone and Firestone operations in the Americas were consolidated in 1990 as Bridgestone/Firestone, Inc.

Bridgestone/Firestone, Inc. initiated a series of changes to its corporate structure in December 2001, reorganizing its operations in the Americas under a holding company, Bridgestone Americas Holding, Inc., and several operating subsidiaries. The largest of these operating subsidiary companies is Bridgestone Retail Operations, LLC. In 2001
Bridgestone/Firestone also announced its majority ownership stake in Morgan Tire & Auto, Inc. (MTA), then the nation's second largest independent retailer of tires. Responsibility for MTA was shifted to Bridgestone Retail Operations, LLC following the reorganization of Bridgestone/Firestone. Today, Bridgestone Retail Operations, LLC and its subsidiaries employ approximately 22,000 teammates in North America. Bridgestone Retail Operations, LLC consists of more than 2,200 company-owned consumer and commercial stores in the United States as well as the company's own credit card operations. The store channels include Firestone Complete Auto Care, Morgan Tire / Tires Plus, Expert Tire, Commercial & Farm, and Mark Morris.







Shreveport, Louisiana, is the third-largest city in the state and serves as the commercial, educational, and cultural hub of the Ark-La-Tex region, where Arkansas, Louisiana, and Texas converge.

As of 2025, the city had a population of approximately 175,151. The median household income is \$48,465, and the cost of living remains notably affordable compared to other metropolitan areas, making Shreveport attractive for families and individuals seeking a reasonable lifestyle.

Shreveport's location in the Ark-La-Tex region places it within convenient driving distance to major hubs like Dallas, TX, and Little Rock, AR, while enjoying proximity to the natural amenities along the Red River.

Strategically located in northwest Louisiana, Shreveport is a key transportation

and logistics hub. It sits about 179 miles from Dallas, 250 miles from Baton Rouge, and 215 miles from Little Rock, placing it within a few hours' drive of several major Southern cities. The city's geography is defined by its position on the Red River, with pine forests, wetlands, and cotton fields surrounding its urban core.

Shreveport's economy has evolved significantly over the decades. Once a national center for the oil and gas industry, the city has diversified into healthcare, manufacturing, logistics, and gaming. Major economic drivers include Barksdale Air Force Base, which employs over 14,000 people, and a robust healthcare sector led by Willis-Knighton Health System and Ochsner LSU Health Shreveport. The casino industry is a significant contributor to entertainment and tourism, with venues like Margaritaville and Sam's Town drawing visitors regionally and generating substantial tax revenue. Recent investments, such as the Amazon Fulfillment Center and the redevelopment of the former General Motors plant, signal ongoing efforts to modernize the city's industrial and digital infrastructure.

In 2023, Shreveport, LA had a population of 183k people with a median age of 37.5 and a median household income of \$48,465. Between 2022 and 2023 the population of Shreveport, LA declined from 186,183 to 183,483, a -1.45% decrease and its median household income grew from \$45,967 to \$48,465, a 5.43% increase.

Economist Dr. Loren Scott told KEEL News on Friday that the Shreveport-Bossier area has reason for optimism.


His latest jobs forecast projects 5,600 new positions by 2027, a number fueled by port activity, technology growth, and surprising expansions from major employers.
